Nursery Missional Mandate

- offering a safe and welcoming place for all infants through children 2 years of age
- offering an environment which lends itself to caring for children according to their developmental stage of life
- offering an opportunity for the church body to serve each other and visitors by caring for their children

Responsibilities

The Nursery Team will be responsible for providing leadership for the care of worshipper's infants and toddlers by...

- ensuring, along with the Youth Discipleship's Abuse Prevention Coordinator, that nursery volunteers have filled out the volunteer application for children's ministries in compliance with BOH's safe church policy
- providing a means for check in / check out of each child with parent's names & cell phone number(s) included
- confirming the nursery is properly staffed each Sunday morning
- quarterly checking the cleanliness and safety of toys and books
- replenishing supplies, i.e. check in/check out sheets, tissues, cleaning supplies, etc
- making sure toys are appropriate for the developmental stage of the children being cared for
- creating a quarterly schedule of nursery attendants

Directives

The Nursery Team will...

- consist of 2-3 members (ideally 3 workers, with 1 going off and 1 on each year)
- serve for a term of 3 years; members are to take a minimum of one year off before serving again
- include a Council Liaison who will be appointed by Council
- be overseen by the Council
